#### MTYC 2021 COVID PROCEDURES

#### > ARRIVAL:

- Driver and occupants will pull up to the Welcome Gazebo where several COVID related questions will be asked. If answers indicate COVID free, driver will proceed.
- Proceed around circle and unload camper's luggage in designated area. Driver will park car in parking area.
- Campers will walk up the Ramp to the back of the Lodge (follow signs) and enter the downstairs entrance. At the 1<sup>st</sup> table, the campers will check in and pick up their T-Shirt and Snack Shack number.
- Campers will proceed to 2<sup>nd</sup> table where they will check in with Pam Armfield (Registrar)
- Campers will proceed to Cabin 7 to check in with the medical personnel.
- Pick up luggage and proceed to assigned cabin with parent(s). Only one parent in cabin at a time.

### > LODGE/ASSEMBLY & MEETINGS

- Campers stay with their assigned cabins, and we will stagger each cabins entrance to the lodge to ensure proper spacing per CDC guidelines.
- Spacing will be maintained during Assembly.
- Hand sanitizing station will be available at each entrance and exit of the lodge.

# DINING/MEALS

- Entrance to dinning area will be staggered by cabin.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at entrance and exit of dining areas.
- Food will be served by kitchen staff who will be wearing masks and sanitation gloves.
- Food and drinks will be served in a manner that minimizes "touch points" by the campers.

# > OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

- Some outdoor activities may require spacing.
- Per CDC recommendations, masks will not be required for any outdoor activities.

# > MEDICAL

- Medical personnel will be on MTYC premises 24/7.
- We will have one Medical facility (cabin 7) designated for any camper who presents with COVID 19 symptoms.
- If a camper presents with COVID 19 symptoms, he or she will be quarantined. Parents will be contacted for immediate pick up. (Parents will have the option of taking their child for a Rapid COVID 19 test, and if they test negative, the camper may be allowed to return to camp. However, other medical issues such as Strep would need to be ruled out.)

### > DAILY PRECAUTIONS

- Counselors will check in with each camper twice per day relative to the COVID symptom questions.
- Hand sanitation stations will be present in each cabin, lodge, Game Room, and dining areas
- Bottled water will be available and "Touchless" water dispenser for personal water bottles.
- Daily sanitizing of each cabin, Lodge, Game Room, and Dining Hall per CDC guidelines.

### > CAMPER PICKUP

- Parents can park in the parking lots and walk up to the cabin their camper(s) are in to get their luggage. Or if the luggage is already in the luggage designated area, they can pull their car up for loading.
- Visiting with others and camp personnel is welcomed, but some spacing recommended.
- Masks not required while outdoors.
